SANTA MONICA, CA (June 20, 2013) – Aniplex of America announced that they have acquired one of the most anticipated titles this season, *Silver Spoon*. *Silver Spoon* will be available for streaming this summer only a few hours following the original airtime in Japan. The series is an adaptation of the popular manga series originally written by author Hiromu Arakawa (*Fullmetal Alchemist*). The studio
